Installation on Vista

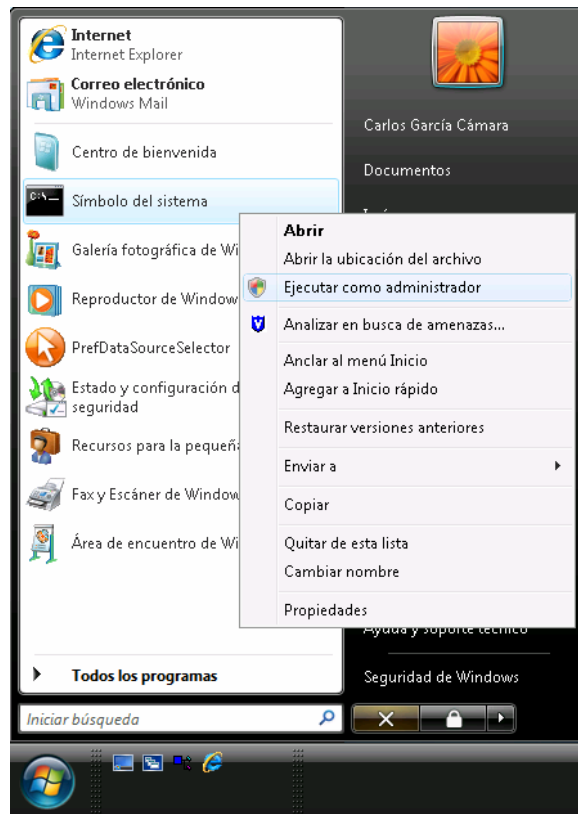

Here you have several notes for install **PrefSuite** in **Windows Vista**:

- You can install PrefSuite from the setup program without doing anything special.
- If you install directly from MSI, you have to follow this easy steps:
 1. Install all pre-requisites that now also include the VC redistributables. You will find this installer in the *vc redistrib* of the installation CD. This is step has to be done only once.
 2. Install the PrefSuite MSI.

If you experiment problems installing the MSI, force it to execute with administrative privileges. In Windows Vista login with an Administrative account does not mean necessarily that all processes are run with administrative privileges. This occurs when UAC (User Account Control) is activated, and is the default configuration in Vista. So to properly install PrefSuite MSI you have to force the installation to have administrative privileges. You can do forcing a command prompt as *Administrator*, for instance, right-click on the command prompt shortcut and select *Run as Administrator*. You can also use the *runas* command.



From the command prompt write (if you have the msi in C:\):

```
msiexec -i "C:\PrefSuite 2006.msi"
```
